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Watercolours

Charcoal drawing

Children learn by exploring form and texture through different media including pencils and charcoal. They will look at the art of Paul Cezanne.

Children learn by exploring clay to make 3D artwork that is made from one single piece of clay.

Children learn by exploring colour and line through using acrylic. They will learn about the work of Van Gogh.

Children learn by exploring texture and form (shading) through charcoal. They learn about the artist Nelson Makamo.

Abstract sculptures

Children learn by exploring the art of Barbara Hepworth and creating their own sculptures by joining clay.

Wave painting

Children learn by exploring colour, texture and line using acrylic paints. They will learn about the art of Hokusai.

Drawing Portraits

Children learn by exploring shape and tone (shading). They draw their own artwork and look at the work of Frida Kahlo.

Clay jars

Children learn by exploring, choosing, selecting and using suitable media. They explore the artwork of Yayoi Kusama.

Children learn by exploring colour and line through using inks and Benday dots. They learn about the artwork of Lichtenstein.

Children learn about form (perspective) and details (texture) through sketching with pencils and charcoal. They explore the work of Lowry and create their own drawings.
