

Developing lifelong learners:

<u>English</u>

This half term will be continuing to do a deep dive into verbs and how impactful they are to our writing. We will be applying out SPAG knowledge from Spring A and applying this to our 'Mixed up Billy Goat Gruff' writing. The children have shown a great interest in our twisted fairy-tale learning and have requested one more story. Finally, we will be moving on to non-fiction writing about The Titanic and creating an informative leaflet

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this half term, children will be learning about shape. They will be identifying and discussing the characteristics of 2D and 3D shapes. After this, we will be moving on to fractions. Children will be recognising and identifying a $\frac{1}{2}$, 1/3, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a shape and quantity.

Topics covered this half term:
