Our Curriculum in Autumn 2

Personal, Social, Emotional Development	We will continue to use the Jigsaw learning resource. This half term the focus is My family and me. The children will spend time discussing making friends, falling out, bullying and being the best friend we can be.
Communication and Language	We will continue to use our thinking hats to support our discussions around lots of different learning areas.
Physical Development	PE will continue to take place on a Monday afternoon with a PE coach and on a Thursday with your child's class teacher.
Literacy	Literacy will be a mix of all our celebrations this half term. We will read and write about bonfire night, Diwali, Remembrance Day, superheroes and Christmas.
	Children will also begin to work in Phonics groups suited to their ability. This will mean that some children will begin to bring home a reading book matched to the phonics group they are in. Please do not worry if your child does not bring home a reading book at first. Books are not sent home until they reach a certain group and have started blending sounds to read words. Please continue to share books at home and reading for pleasure.
Mathematics	In maths we will continue to explore numbers up to 5 and what makes that number. We will compare amounts and look at whole numbers and parts of the numbers. We will also spend time exploring shapes.
Understanding the world	We will be exploring magnets. The children will be challenged to find things that magnets stick to and use the power of magnets to make a superhero fly. The children will also be learning the nativity story.
Expressive Art and Design	In art this half term we will be planning and making superhero capes for Supertato and making Christmas cards and calendars.
