<u>Developing lifelong learners:</u>

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English

In English this half term, we are going to be focusing on two engaging Space texts called 'The Marvellous Moon Map' by Teresa Heapy and 'The Darkest Dark' by Astronaut Chris Hadfield.

The children will be using these texts to learn to how to write a non-chronological report and a narrative. Alongside writing for a purpose, the children will be learning new spelling rules, using punctuation for effect and writing sentences that are grammatically correct.

Maths

In Maths this half term, the children will be continuing their learning on addition and subtraction using a variety of methods to solve problems. We will then move on to explore money by identifying the value of coins and notes as well as learning to solve money problems where the children will be required to apply known strategies to support them. Before the end of term, the children will move on to learn about multiplication and division.

Topics covered this half term:

Design and Technology - This half term the children will be designing a functional space buggy based on design criteria.

Science - In Science this half term the children will be learning about materials.

History - This half term we will be finding out about a significant person. To link with our space topic the children will be learning about Neil Armstrong and make comparisons with an English astronaut Tim Peake.

Computing - what is IT?

Music - Christmas Themed Music

R.E - This half term we will be learning about The Christmas Story with a focus on 'Advent'.
