
## YEAR 1 NEWSLETTER

In 'Talk Through Stories' our focus texts will be Zog and Victorian Schools (Non-Fiction)





In **Mathematics** we will be focusing on types of measure including length, mass and capacity. We will then move onto naming and recognising coins and notes, any practice that you can do at home would be a great help.

In **English** we will exploring diaries linked to the story Zog then move onto a recount of our day as a Victorian school child. We will be working on extending our sentences and continue to practice our handwriting. Spellings will also continue to be given out weekly, with the spelling check taking place on a Monday.

In **History** we will be learning about the Victorians and we plan to have a Victorian school day on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> March.** There is no requirement to buy a costume as a white school t-shirt and grey trousers or a school dress is fine but here are some ideas if you would like to.





Foundation Subjects	
Year 1 will be covering the following subjects this half term.	
Science	10 <sup>th</sup> – 15 <sup>th</sup> March is British Science Week and the theme is 'adapt and change'. To launch this Year 1 will be attending a science fair on Friday 7 <sup>th</sup> March at St Marys Church (no cost and within school time).
	During Science week we will have Science sessions within different classes during the week, finding out about inspirational scientists and carrying out our own experiments.
Art	Our artwork will focus on sculpture and we will create our clay tile. Later in the term we will learn how to weave with different materials to make a final product ready for Easter.
History	We will be finding out the work of Florence Nightingale and why she is an important person from the past. To support our learning we will visit Fort Nelson – please see the letter for dates for your child's class and request for parent helpers which we are short of!
RE	As Easter approaches we will learn about the Christian celebration of Palm Sunday and make a visit to St James Church to find about celebrating Easter.
PE	Foxglove and Both Green and Yellow team will have PE on Tuesday afternoon. Please ensure that your child wears PE kit on these days.
