HOME LEARNING SUGGESTIONS

Create a 3D model of a biome (shoebox, lego etc). Make sure to include the correct geographical features for your chosen biome.

Eco-Hotel Design — Design a wildlife-friendly hotel for a chosen animal, explaining how it meets their needs (e.g., shelter, food sources).

Food Chain Poster — Illustrate a food chain from a specific habitat, explaining the role of each organism.

Camouflage Experiment — Hide different colored paper "moths" outside and check which ones are easiest to find, linking to predator-prey relationships.
